



We offer minor repairs to exterior wood. The repairs we complete are primarily board replacement. We do not do structural repairs and we are not licensed carpenters. Our rate is \$90.00 per hour. If you can have the wood at the job site, that will reduce the cost of the repair. Below are the 2 possible options, please let us know which one you would prefer.

Option 1:

You are able to purchase the type and quantity of wood needed and have it available for us at the job site.

1. It does not matter if the repair is done before, during or after the cleaning and sealing/staining process.
2. Please mark the boards that you would like replaced.
3. We will then replace the boards indicated with the boards you have provided.
4. We will charge \$90.00 per hour from the time we arrive to the time we finish the repair.

Option 2:

You choose to have us acquire the materials.

1. It does not matter if the repair is done before, during or after the cleaning and sealing/staining process.
2. Please mark the boards that you would like replaced.
3. We will arrive at your location, identify the work to be done and the type and number of boards required. If needed, we may remove a board to try to match.
4. We will go to the lumber yard or yards and purchase the required materials.
5. We will return and replace the boards indicated by you with the boards we have purchased.
6. We will bill for the cost of the materials plus \$90.00 per hour from the time we arrive at the project site to identify the materials needed, the time to go to the lumber yard, shop at the lumber yard, and return from the lumber yard, to the time we finish the repair.

It is important to know that after staining the color of the new wood will not match the color of the current wood. The only way to match the color would be to paint the wood which we do not recommend. After several years, the new wood will age and blend in with the current wood.
